ARIZONA

Our Red Sands Christian School continues to grow and share God's love beyond their school walls! A local newspaper columnist shared that the school has made a positive impact in the community and he is grateful for their presence. The school is excited about a new, commercial kitchen! Recent, generous donations enabled this project to start. When finished, this will be an incredible blessing for our students and community!

A new church also launched in September 2019! The Well seeks to reach those who are distant from God in the Winslow community. The church meets at the Red Sands school, in hope to minister to the students' parents. The church continues to grow, serve the community, and remain focused on outreach to the lost. With three baptisms thus far, the church is excited about their future! The Well is a church plant partnership between Lifeline and Nexus, a church planting organization.

Ministry continues to those living on the streets of Winslow who struggle with addictions. Part of the ministry includes the staff, students, and parents who make sandwiches and assemble bags for those in need. It's a simple gesture to share God's love!

Lifeline is excited about a new church plant in the Vancouver, British Columbia area! The launch of Tableside Church has been two years filled with prayers, planning, and preparations! Jaron and Robin, and their young family have been living in the Vancouver area for a couple of years now. By serving in residence with Kurt Kuykendall/Mercy Hill Christian Church, Jaron has had time to explore the kind of church planting model and the church locations that will work best. Already, around 30 people are meeting together, and an outreach group is up and running. They are even considering launching a second “micro-church”!

Since the beginning, Lifeline has been a supporter of this new church and a catalyst to bring other partners into the support network. Lifeline serves on the Tableside Church Management Team. This team will help the young church until they are ready to create their own leadership team.

Lifeline also continues to connect Canadian churches to ministry opportunities. Through meal packing events and mission trips, more people are experiencing the joy of serving God and knowing Him better!

CUBA

For the first time, Lifeline sent a container filled with our rice-based meals to the Cuban churches! The churches were thrilled to receive them! These meals are used to minister to elderly believers who are in need. The Cuban economy is in a severe downturn and many families are struggling. Thus, the church would love to receive more meals!

Another exciting opportunity: a small group of pastors traveled to Baracoa on the far eastern part of Cuba. This team of Honduran and U.S. pastors held leadership training seminars in five house churches. Each church was challenged to transform their neighborhoods with the practical love of Christ.

Speaking of teams, Cuba is open to visiting mission teams! Teams focusing on leadership development, children's ministry, and sports ministry are much needed. The Cuban people are hungry to learn, love visitors, and are encouraged by teams that help them share God's love with their neighbors.

The ministry in Quito centers around a Christian school that is transforming students! The school has an excellent reputation that reaches deep into the community. By focusing on six pillars, students discover that school is more than an education. And this year, they will celebrate their first graduating class! The future of this school is bright with its talented staff!

Lifeline has also dreamed of having a broader spiritual impact in Quito. Thus, in January 2020, a small team began building relationships with other churches and Christian leaders in the area. The team prayed for “people of peace” who might open the door for some type of ministry focus. The response - in just 5 days - was overwhelming! Nearly 60 church leaders attended a seminar on discipleship and multiplication! Many of these leaders had virtually no prior knowledge of Lifeline. Afterwards, a core group of influencers gathered. They are eager for more, discussing ways for that to happen, and pledging their full support. Now, Lifeline staff are quickly putting a plan in place to join what God is already doing!

EL SALVADOR

Developing new leaders, springing up new house churches, and planting new churches - that's what ministry in El Salvador is all about. To facilitate this growth, Lifeline partners with churches in El Salvador. Through leadership seminars, mission trips, and church connections the local church is encouraged!

Healthy, growing relationships are the basis of the church to church program. This program connects churches in El Salvador with churches in the U.S. and Canada. These one-on-one connections ensure encouragement and deepening friendships. Financial assistance helps churches in El Salvador buy property and build buildings. This creates stable Christian communities that are drawing more people to Jesus!

A strong network of churches and church leaders is another key aspect of this ministry. Ministry is hard and leaders struggle! By working together and enjoying fellowship, leaders are encouraged. With the vast number of opportunities God has placed before us, the ministry is just getting started!

GUATEMALA

It's exciting to see God producing fruit in Guatemala! At the beginning of January 2020, three new people were baptized into Christ!

God is also opening doors to grow the ministry. In late 2019, two apprentices joined the ministry. These pastors recently graduated from Lifeline's Bible Institute in San Pedro Sula, Honduras. (One is from Honduras, while the other is from the community.) These young leaders are eager to serve! They have jumped in with door-to-door evangelism, leading Bible studies, pastoral visits to encourage people to take their next step of faith, and preaching in the house churches. They are also sowing seeds to expand the ministry into new communities! It will be exciting to see how God uses these two young Kingdom workers!

HAITI

Lifeline's strong Haitian leadership kept ministry moving forward, despite the political chaos in 2019. These Haitian leaders stepped up to lead the staff through challenging circumstances! Ministries were open and continued to serve the community. Also, staff gathered each morning to pray, worship God, and encourage each other. As a result of the morning gatherings, one of the security guards recently gave his life to Christ!

It's exciting to share that schools are open and classes have resumed in January 2020! Due to the chaos, schools were closed in the fall of 2019. Classrooms are again filled with the sounds of laughter and learning.

Empowering and equipping our Haitian leaders and pastors has been a priority. The staff went through several trainings led by Life in Abundance, a partner organization. Staff learned more about "community." Discussions helped them understand their specific community, what a Christian community looks like, God's vision for community, and God's intention for the nations. The staff have already begun to incorporate these new tools into their ministry! It will be exciting to watch these leaders stretch their wings and grow into their God-given potential!

HONDURAS

A new, bilingual school opened, which means more students are hearing God's Word! This school teaches both Spanish and English, along with a Christian education. (Bilingual speakers are in high demand in Central America.) Based in the capital city of Tegucigalpa, the school is in a community that struggles with poverty. The school started with 23 preschoolers and is adding a class every year.

Two graduates from Lifeline's Bible Institute are eager to serve in ministry! Although they just graduated in December 2019, these young pastors are already serving in the local church. After graduation, Bryan returned to his home country of Guatemala. He is serving with Pastor Deybee and the church in San Jose de Pinula. Fernando, who also graduated, is serving locally in Honduras.

Ten students were recently baptized! They participated in a discipleship program at Ocotillo Christian Church. This was an intentional time to memorize Bible verses and to serve others. Through this experience, they learned how to be a disciple not just a follower.



HONDURAS



PANAMA

Local Lifeline leaders are dedicated to taking the Gospel to the indigenous people in Panama! Traveling to these remote tribes is very labor intensive. Often, staff and church members walk two to six hours on mountain roads. They may also need to drive double-traction cars for two hours to reach a community and preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. To help with their efforts, Lifeline has equipped these pastors, leaders, and church members through leadership seminars. And more than 100 Bibles have also been given away. Through this training and their zeal to share God's Word, the church is multiplying!

A new church is getting ready to launch in Panama City! Lifeline and partnering churches in the U.S. have spent much time in prayer, planning, and preparation for this church. This is a unique launch in the heart of Panama City, which is highly diverse due to the influence of the Panama Canal. A mission team helped with a pre-launch kids camp and more than 500 children attended! It's exciting to watch God move and see people eager to know more about Him!

UGANDA

Late fall marked one year since BeFriend Adjumani launched, where 265 families befriended a community in Uganda. There has been a lot of progress!

Through prayer, 377 people in Adjumani have received Jesus Christ in their lives! And 4 discipleship groups are walking with them in this new journey of salvation! In addition, 20 church leaders were trained on discipleship, entrepreneurship, and reporting. Through economic empowerment, 16 self help groups have been formed. These groups are going through mentorship and training in a wholistic approach. Every month, 200 households are receiving food and basic needs. In addition, a store has been set up to supply food and other items.

A saving and credit association has been formed by the pastors of the partner churches. And 200 children have had the opportunity to go to school because the BeFriend program paid for their school fees. God is working in incredible ways! We are excited for what God will do during the next two years of this friendship! (BeFriend is a collaboration between Life in Abundance, Lifeline Christian Mission, and a partner church.)




